Consult:

relevant experts

relevant stakeholders



What have I learned?

The people responsible for the drafting must think about the impacts from the beginning of the work

Impacts can be dealt with and adjusted/minimized/maximized during the work on the Bill

Team work is always useful. Diverse teams lead to the best results

The team leader should have good oversight and access necessary expertise and data

Impact assessment is not something that should only be done at the very end of the drafting
