





Emergency response to tropical storm Ana

Responding to the needs of the most vulnerable in the aftermath of tropical storm Ana

Implementing partner: WFP

Programme period: 2022

Budget: \$319,081 USD

Location: Chikwawa, Phalombe and Nsanje Districts

Summary: In the aftermath of Tropical Storm Ana, severe flooding hit southern Malawi, leaving at least 990,000 people in need of lifesaving and life-sustaining humanitarian assistance and protection, including 190,400 people who were displaced by floods.

A contribution from Iceland of USD 319,081 (ISK 40 million) for cash transfers supported 45,000 people (about 10,000 households) in the hardest-hit communities, contributing to the overall response of the Government and the development partners.

Participants were provided with cash-based transfers worth MWK 18,000 per household (approximately USD 23), equivalent to the value of 75 percent of the monthly food basket (of 50kg cereals, 10kg pulses and 1.84kg of vegetable oil) for one month for food security response.
